How does Pewabic work with homeowners or trade professionals?

An initial free 45 minute design consultation is provided. Our in-house designers will utilize that time to learn about your preferences and goals. Our designers can also It is important for clients to bring as much information to the initial meeting as possible (drawings, dimensions, photos, surface samples, and an installation deadline). Walk-in appointments can't always be accommodated because our designers are frequently off-site. Can I obtain samples or Pewabic field tiles and embossed tiles?

Pewabic is happy to provide 3"x3" field tile samples. Embossed tile samples are available for loan, and special order samples are available for purchase. There will be a 3-4 week wait for all special orders. Samples can be shipped as well. There is no charge for the samples; however, the client is required to pay for shipping.

Some natural color variance is a normal and expected part of each Pewabic tile. This variation creates the signature beauty of the Pewabic "look" and is due to the hand-crafted nature of the tile we have been fabricating for nearly a century.

How much time does Pewabic need to complete my project?

Our fabrication studio takes approximately 12-16 weeks to create handcrafted tiles design especially for you. Rush orders are normally available for an additional fee. Please make sure to mention all personal deadlines and event dates.

We are one of the Nation's oldest potteries still in existence. Founded in 1903, at the height of the Arts and Crafts movement, Pewabic Pottery is a studio for the design of custom architectural tile, gift tile, and vessel wares. We also offer year-round classes for adults and children.
